Section 1 Baked Products

SPECIAL INFORMATION:

1. Complete baked goods must be brought to the Fair. After judging, the fair may display only a portion of the product for the fair event.
2. Baked goods become the property of the fair. The exhibitor must have made all products.
3. Food products cannot be polluted with any substance or chemical that caused them to become poisonous or unfit to be used for food.
4. **All baked goods must be in clear ziplock plastic bags on foam or plastic plates;** except iced cakes or decorated cakes, which may be covered with plastic wrap, in a cardboard cake box or a plastic domed cake cover. Pie and cake carriers are available for exhibitors a week before the Fair – 6:00 to 7:00 PM.
5. No food requiring refrigeration will be accepted. Pies – NO cream or Custard pies will be accepted for exhibition. Pies should be in disposable aluminum pie plates.
6. All items entered in the “Other class” must be identified and named.

4. Refrigeration is NOT available at the fair or the PA Farm Show. Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entering will not be sold, auctioned or otherwise distributed for consumption after judging for food safety reason.
5. Cake entry must be submitted for judging on cardboard.
6. Recipe(s) listing the ingredients and the preparation instructions must be submitted with the entry (printed on one side of an 8 ½ x 11" size paper). Entrants name, address and phone number must be printed on the back of all papers.
7. Judging Criteria:

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| Flavor (smell, taste, flavoring) | 30 points |
| Inside Characteristics (texture & lightness) | 20 points |
| Overall Appearance (surface, size, color) | 20 points |
| Creativity | 15 points |
| Topping, Icing, Decoration | 10 points |
| Total Points = | 100 |
